### STATEMENT OF FAITH

**(This document is to be agreed to and signed by all staff, regular volunteers in the office and in the prisons, and members of the Board of Directors.)**

We are called by God to share the love of Jesus Christ with all those impacted by incarceration. Through the programs and services of Kingsway Prison and Family Outreach, we offer to prison inmates, their families, and those who work with them the opportunity to receive God's forgiveness through faith in Jesus Christ, and to grow in their faith and service in Christian community.

We stand on common ground in the belief that the following tenets of our faith are consistent with Biblical truth.

We believe:

- That the Bible is truly the inspired and authoritative Word of God.
- In the eternal Trinity of God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.
- In the deity, sinless life, atoning death, bodily resurrection, ascension, and future return of Jesus Christ.
- That salvation is by God's grace alone, through faith in Jesus Christ alone.
- That the Christian life is possible only by the indwelling power of the Holy Spirit enabling us to live a godly and sanctified life.
- That God offers forgiveness and redemption to all who confess and forsake their sins.
- That all human life was created by God in His image and is sacred.
- That God creates each human as uniquely male or female, in God's image, and has ordained marriage and defined it as the covenant relationship between a man, a woman, and Himself.
- That the love of Jesus Christ inspires His followers to provide food for the hungry, drink for the thirsty, welcome to the stranger, clothes for the naked, and visits to the sick and to those in prison (Matthew 25:35-36) .
