From The President of the Board of Directors

Merry Christmas! Christmas is still a few months away, but we get started in July. You know, Christmas in July!!

We are starting our campaign for toothpaste for the inmates. Have you ever thought about what a luxury toothpaste is? I know for a fact that the inmates can tell you. One Christmas at Augusta Correctional Center before the facility closed, Kingsway volunteers were giving to the inmates the gift bags containing the items which you had helped us to obtain. Someone called out “Toothpaste, I haven’t had toothpaste since March!”

Can you imagine not having toothpaste? I can’t. Something we take for granted and yet not everyone has it.

We are asking for this now, to help remind you later down the road. We are looking at about 8,000 inmates for Christmas this year. So it will take each of you to donate at least one tube of toothpaste.

You can make a BIG difference to someone by doing this one gesture. Can we count on you? Kingsway has given inmates Christmas gifts for as long as I can remember, and now we give the toothpaste, a 5x8 mini legal pad, and a chapstick. We used to ask for those gifts, but have found they can be ordered, so this takes a responsibility off of you.

Please consider giving a tube of toothpaste. Sizes of the tubes are 3-ounce to no larger than 6-ounce. Please, no Crest w/Scope. The reason for this is Scope has alcohol in it and is not allowed in any prisons.

I would like to let you know that we now have a daytime program available for Mothers of Prisoners that is taking place on the 2nd Wednesday of the month. Also starting soon is the program for female spouses. These programs are support groups. You are not alone!

The God that we serve is amazing and faithful! God opened the door for Vicki Barb and me to meet the new Director of the Virginia Department of Corrections in February. It was a good meeting, and we enjoyed getting a glimpse of his vision for the DOC for the coming years. As we prepared to meet him, we pulled out the map created by our Webmaster, Pappy Pless (please look for it elsewhere in this newsletter), and added a few statistics that show how God has used Kingsway (and **you**, through your generosity) in the Shenandoah Valley and the whole state of Virginia in 2025.

This map and the statistics are even more amazing when you consider that everything Kingsway does is accomplished almost entirely by our matchless volunteers! I know that we didn't capture hours from everyone, but in 2025, more than 35 volunteers donated over 5,300 hours of their time. If we had paid them minimum wage (and they're worth more, MUCH MORE), the time with which they gifted Kingsway would have equaled \$65,773.00.

I am consistently humbled and amazed by the ways that God provides for Kingsway through financial gifts, and for putting it on the hearts of our caring volunteers to be the hands and feet of Jesus by living out the actions that mean so much to our King, as in Matthew 25: to feed the hungry and thirsty, to invite the stranger in and to clothe them, and to visit those in prison. That is God's love that our volunteers demonstrate every single day!

God continues to open doors at Kingsway. In 2025, we started taking cards and candy to the youth living in juvenile detention. One of them sent a letter of appreciation (included in the Testimonies section). When I told the staff at the juvenile detention center about it, they told us that she is not usually someone who says, "Thank you." God alone knows how your prayers, a card, and a little candy are speaking to their hearts and reminding them that they are not forgotten.

God also opened the door with our Probation and Parole office here in Harrisonburg. In partnership with them, we are piloting a program to offer hygiene kits to returning offenders in their care. While we are not able to add a card that says, "Come to Kingsway," we are able to show the recipients God's love in this way. If everything goes well, we hope to open this opportunity to all of the inmates going through probation and parole there.

Please pray for these projects and join us in asking God where He wants Kingsway to branch out next.

I was introduced to Kingsway one day when I was shopping nearby. At the time, my grandson in Florida was in jail on a drug charge, and I was intrigued by the name Kingsway Prison and Family Outreach. I visited the office and met Louise, Pam, and Vicki. After several months I began to volunteer there. I loved what Kingsway was accomplishing for people who were reentering society after having been incarcerated, and wanted to be a part of it. When I started in the fall of 2024, we were in the midst of preparing for Christmas. We were preparing gifts for inmates, and soon after, began addressing Christmas cards for them. It was an extremely busy time and I loved it!!

As much as I loved volunteering there, I never dreamed that in the winter of my life I'd be working again, but I found that Kingsway provided a much-needed place in my life. I have worked in offices since I was 16 years old, and I needed that busyness and being able to get out among like-minded people and do something productive for the Kingdom. I am a widow with grown children and grandchildren, an active attendee of my church, and am also involved as a leader in Celebrate Recovery at my church. I like staying active and spending time with others – it keeps me young!

I am deeply grateful to the Board of Directors of Kingsway for the opportunity to serve Jesus in this capacity.

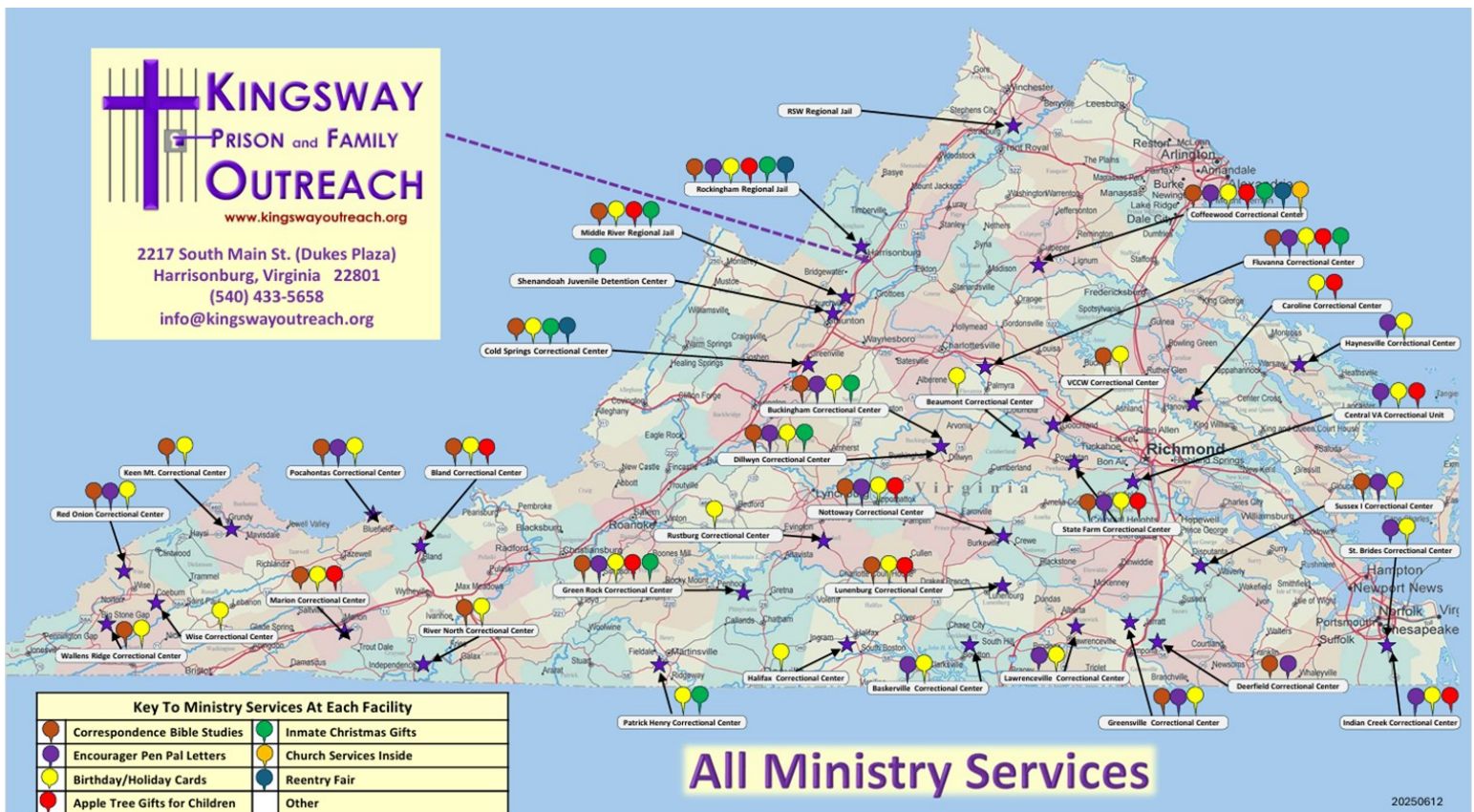
KINGSWAY HAPPENINGS

PAST, PRESENT, FUTURE

JUST A FEW NUMBERS FOR 2025

- ◆ Kingsway provided Christmas gifts (notepad, toothpaste, lip balm, and card) for 7200 inmates in 14 facilities. In 2026, Kingsway hopes to add another facility or two.
- ◆ Kingsway sends birthday cards and holiday cards (Valentines Day, Easter, July 4th, Thanksgiving, & Christmas) to approximately 2500 inmates, who reside in every VADOC facility.
- ◆ Kingsway gave gifts to almost 400 children of inmates through the Apple Tree Program, which picks up after Angel Tree closes. Apple Tree guarantees a minimum of a game, a toy, and a Bible, and fosters connection between the inmates and their children. Inmates from 16 facilities participated in 2025.
- ◆ Kingsway has 262 individuals from 22 different facilities receiving Correspondence Bible Studies.
- ◆ Kingsway assisted 246 individuals with reentry needs (sober living housing, cell phones, work shoes, hygiene items, a packed meal, clothing, and job and community referrals).
- ◆ Kingsway offers Encourager Pen Pals to 111 participants living in 23 facilities.
- ◆ Kingsway takes part in Reentry Fairs in 4 facilities.
- ◆ Kingsway offers church services in 2 facilities.
- ◆ Kingsway employs an Executive Director and one Administrative Assistant. They are both part-time employees.
- ◆ In 2025, more than 35 volunteers gave Kingsway over 5300 hours of service.
- ◆ Kingsway looks for opportunities to encourage the GracelInside Chaplains and the Virginia Department of Corrections staff.

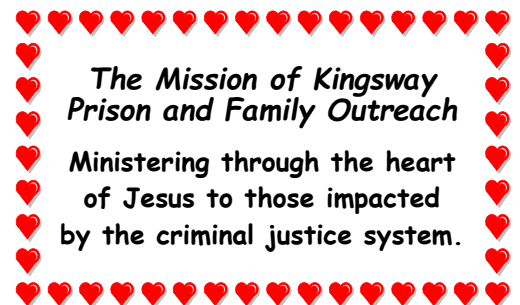
